<u>archaeologist</u>- a person who digs up remains of ancient cities and towns and studies the ways humans lived a long time ago

<u>era</u>- a period of time or of history

preserved- kept from being lost, damaged, or decayed; protected

**reconstruct**- to put parts back together again
